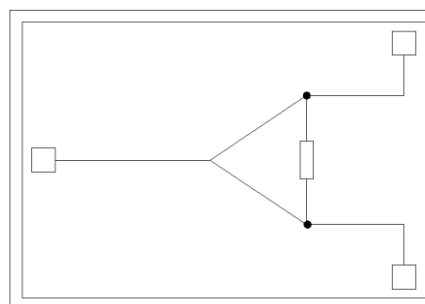

General Description

XT3801A is a GaAs MMIC 2-way 0° power divider which operates between 2GHz ~ 20GHz with insertion loss 1.2dB and VSWR 1.3.

Functional Diagram



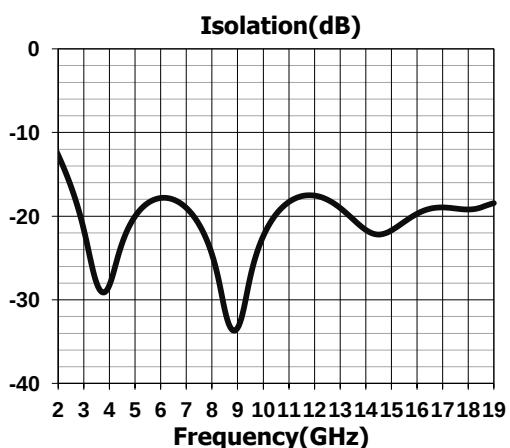
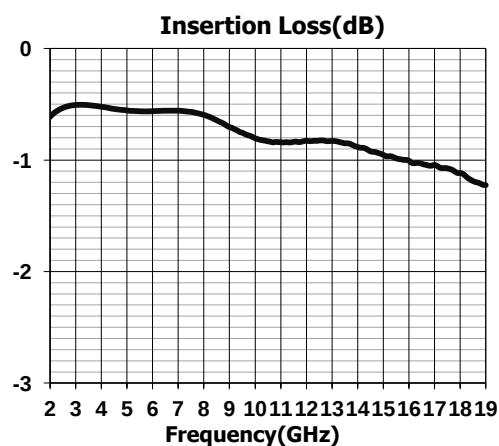
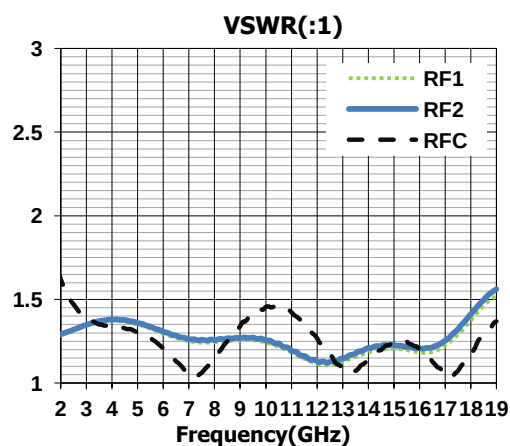

Typical Performance Curve



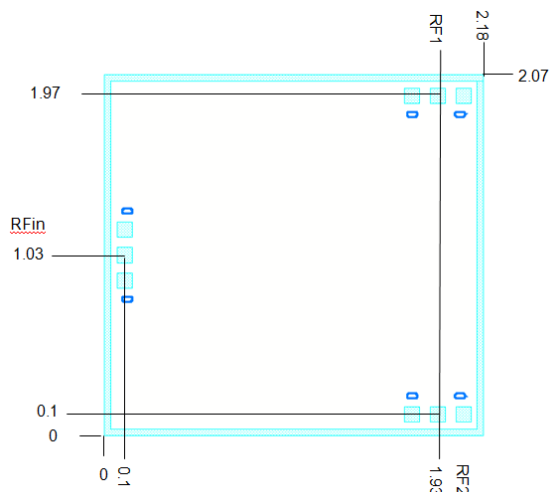

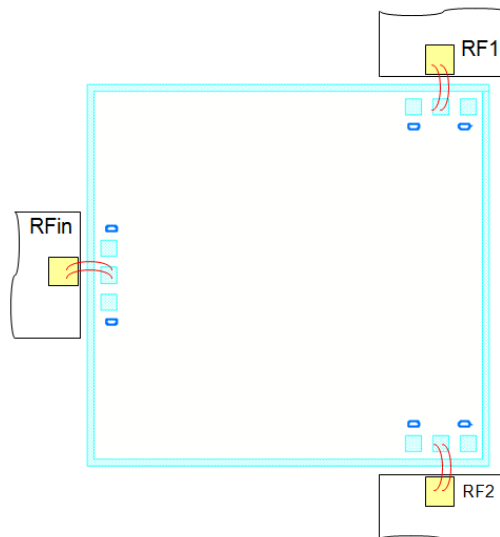
GaAs MMIC Power Divider
