The chip offers full passivation for increased reliability and moisture protection.

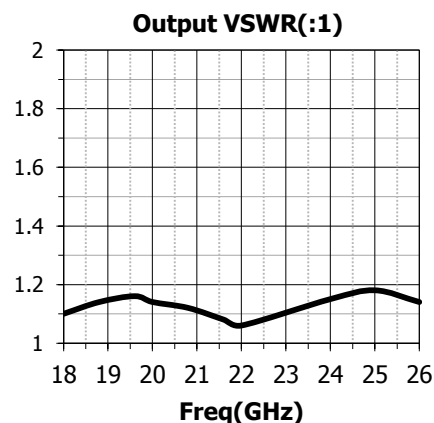
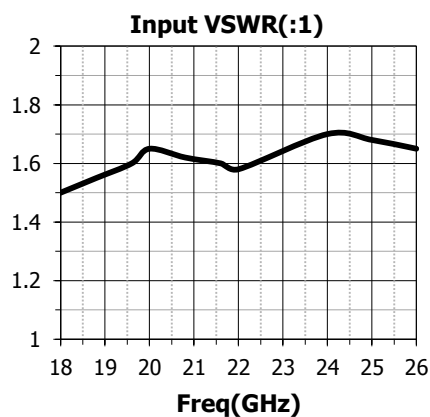

Typical Performance Curve

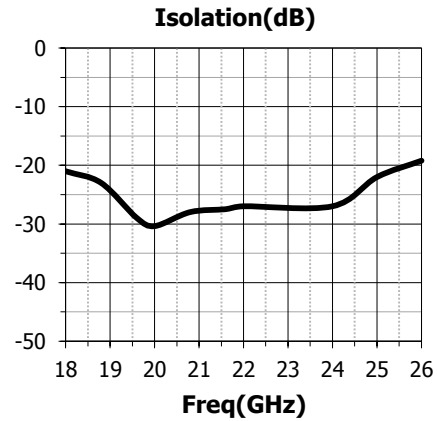

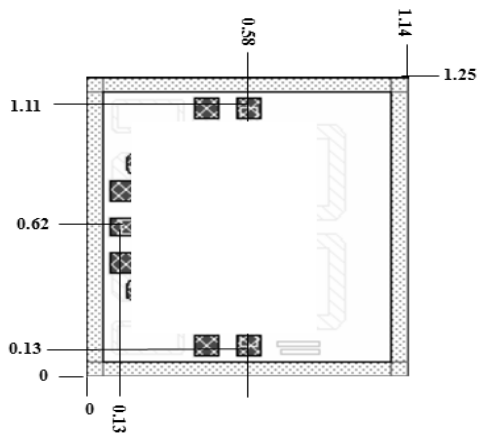


GaAs MMIC Power Divider
18~26GHz

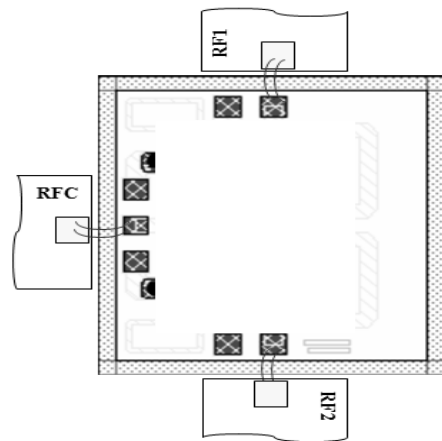
